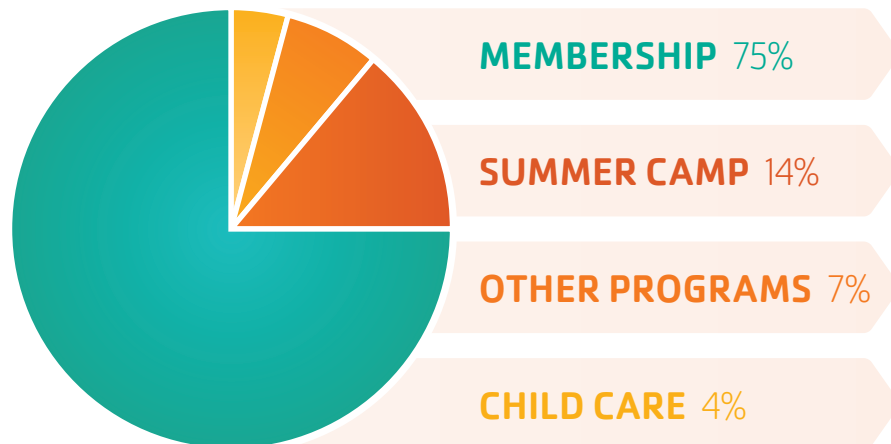

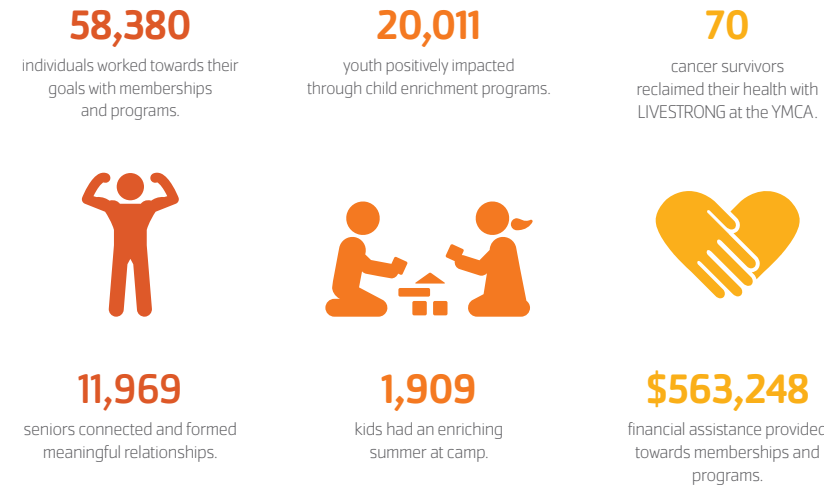

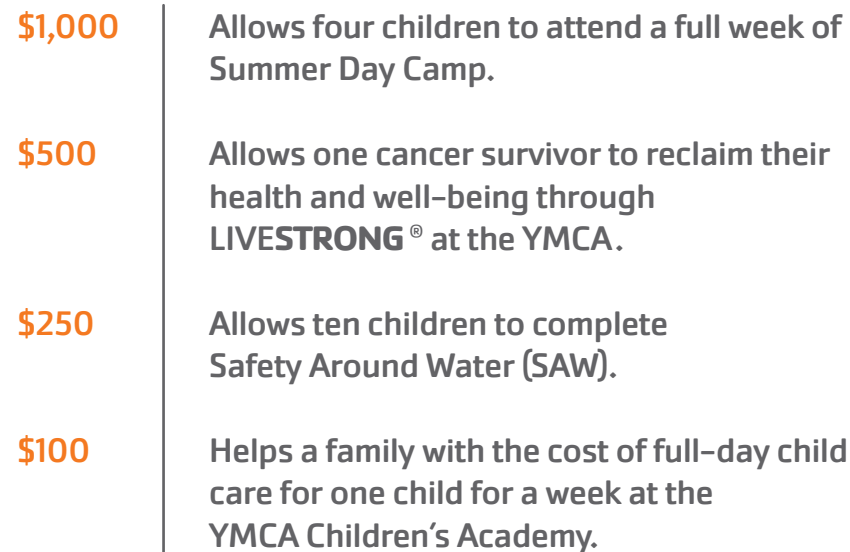

\$17,467

was provided to support youth in learning life-saving water safety skills through **Swim Lessons** and **Safety Around Water (SAW)** programs.



\$22,354
